“The promise of economic, social & cultural growth now belong to our people. After meeting the mandate to bring a treaty back to the community, we are now embarking on a brighter future - one filled with opportunity and prosperity,” said Chief Councillor Vi Mundy.

Today, the Ucluelet people stand proudly with the other Maa-nulth people to take their rightful place in the social, cultural and economic fabric of British Columbia and Canada.
