

## MAA-NULTH FIRST NATIONS SIDE AGREEMENT SUMMARY

### UCHUCKLESAHT TRIBE: OYSTER BEACH LETTER

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of letter (“Oyster Beach Letter”) is to set out Canada’s commitment to review a request by Uchucklesaht Tribe to add Vernon Bay as an oyster beach to Schedule 7 of the Final Agreement.

The parties to the Oyster Beach Letter are Uchucklesaht Tribe and Canada.

#### **How the Agreement Works**

The letter came into effect on the date of Initialing of the Final Agreement: December 9, 2006.

Canada agrees to review Uchucklesaht’s request and if they are able to, will carry out the request before ratification of the Final Agreement by Uchucklesaht Tribe.

The Parties are responsible for their own costs in the negotiations of this issue.

#### **What Comes Next**

The request is currently under review by Canada.
